Permitting Complete




- USACE Section 404/10
- Ecology Section 401 Water Quality Certification
- DPD/Ecology Shoreline Permit
- WDFW Hydraulic Project Approval
- DNR Easement/Right-of-Entry
- NOAA Marine Mammal Protection Act Letter of Authorization



Contract Executed



- The City and Mortenson/Manson Joint Venture (GC/CM) have executed a contract for major elements of construction
- Approximately 60% of subcontracted work has been bid



Construction Launched



- Construction began Monday, November 18







Maintaining a Safe Work Environment



- **Traffic Control Plans and other safety procedures submitted and approved**
 - Inspectors on-site
 - Flaggers
 - Signage for pedestrians and drivers
- **Everyone on site is required to attend, at least, a one-hour safety training**
 - Additional trainings required for certain on-site jobs



Environmental Compliance



- **Compliance and monitoring**

- Plans in place to comply with all mandates outlined in environmental permits

- Water quality
 - Cultural resources
 - Marine mammals and wildlife



Environmental Updates



- **Supplemental Draft Environmental Impact Statement to be released December 16**
 - Analyzes changes to the project as a result of the shoreline appeal resolution
 - Update to current construction methods/sequencing
