**Budget Action description:**

This green sheet would appropriate an additional \$100,000 in GSF resources to the Legislative Department to fund and analysis of the economic impacts associated with establishing a minimum wage within the City of Seattle at a level above the current State minimum. The analysis would be conducted by an outside, independent consultant. Central Staff would work with Councilmembers, who intend to coordinate collaboratively with representatives from labor and business, to define the scope of the study. Central staff would conduct the procurement process and manage the work of the selected consultant. While the time line of the analysis has not yet been determined, results might be reasonably anticipated in the third quarter of 2014.
