## BASIC MISSION

- ▶ **VISION:** Working together, Delivering Opportunity, Innovation, and Technology
- ▶ **MISSION:** We partner with our customers to provide reliable and secure information and communication solutions that make technology work for the City.
- ▶ **DoIT** enables:
  - ▶ Police/Fire to receive 911 calls, dispatch staff, and communicate
  - ▶ City services, information, and staff to be accessed via telephones, email, websites, television, and social media
  - ▶ Availability of City business services: permits get issued, bills get paid, courts get scheduled
  - ▶ Computer access and training for residents in need



# KEY OUTCOMES and REMAINING CHALLENGES

## Outcomes:

- ▶ Increased redundancy, availability, and security.
- ▶ Technology is leveraged as effectively as possible.
- ▶ City IT services are coordinated and duplication of efforts and costs is reduced.

## Challenges:

- ▶ Efficiency – reduce duplication, overlaps, silos
- ▶ IT Business Continuity/Disaster Recovery
- ▶ Rapidly changing environment
