Emmitsburg, MD




On August 19-23, the City of Seattle sent a 69 member team back to Emmitsburg, MD.

The team consisted of 47 city department representatives and 22 agency and regional partners.

The Integrated Emergency Management Courses (IEMCs) are a 4½-day exercise-based training activity that places Emergency Operations Center (EOC) personnel under realistic crisis situations within a structured learning environment.

The course provided the Seattle team the opportunity to practice team-oriented skills away from the distractions of “home” and the office.
