

In order to better prepare myself for aging with functional limitations as well as learn more about the issues, I feel I need to become involved in a local organization whose primary purpose focuses on individuals who are aging and aging into disability. From the description offered on your website, your organization is actively involved in many of these issues.

As I indicated in my cover letter, I have worked with individuals with disabilities and rehabilitation organizations for over 40 years in a variety of setting and states. I am currently the Director for the University of Washington Center on Continuing Education in Rehabilitation. We provide continuing education and technical assistance on issues facing professionals and organizations working in rehabilitation. In addition, one sector of our organization is the Northwest ADA Center which provides training and technical assistance on the Americans with Disabilities Act. We are hearing more requests for information from aging workers regarding accommodations in the workplace and other employment related issues. We are also hearing from rehabilitation professionals working in the field the need for additional tools in working with individuals with disabilities who are seeking employment.
