City of Seattle Capital GREEN Updates

ArchEcology worked with the City of Seattle to develop Capital GREEN, a program that provides a consistent comprehensive sustainable approach to widely varied construction projects ranging from small projects, to tenant improvements and renovations. The program was updated and expanded in 2013 for a City-wide roll out.

Denny Terrace Measurement & Verification

ArchEcology was retained by a local architect to model the energy and water use profile of an existing high rise apartment building for the Seattle Housing Authority and recommend renovation strategies that could achieve energy and water use reduction goals. With construction now complete, Nancy is calibrating this model to measure actual annual usage and verify the achievement of reduction goals.
