In this role she manages the successful day-to-day operations of the executive branch of County government. She directly oversees the nine department directors in the Executive's cabinet, and is the first point of contact for controversial or problematic issues. Berry oversees 13,700 employees, the multi-million dollar budget, and the implementation of the Executive's reform initiatives. She also advises on the operational impacts of new initiatives and helps to implement them.

For the past 19 years, Berry worked at the City of Tukwila, the past five years as City Administrator with responsibility for eight department directors, 315 full-time employees, and a general operating budget of about \$45 million. She began as support staff to the Mayor and the City Administrator, which culminated in her being appointed as the City Administrator. Key responsibilities included constituent relations and intergovernmental relations.
