

## **EXPERIENCE**

### *Current*

#### **Executive Director, Government Affairs; BNSF Railway Co.**

Responsible for oversight of state legislative, local government and in-state congressional issues. Supervise contract consultants in Washington, Oregon and British Columbia. Develop legislative and government affairs plans for the Northwest and represent BNSF before legislatures, agencies, municipal and county councils on issues of railroad operation, regulatory activity, taxes and fees, and many and diverse local issues. Currently serve as a gubernatorial appointee to the Washington Freight Mobility Strategic Investment Board and am a member of the state Rail Advisory Board, Oregon State Rail Advisory Board and the Oregon Freight Advisory Board. Most recently appointed by the governor to a special Rail Funding Committee for Oregon.

### *December 1995 to 2007*

#### **Manager, Government Relations; Port of Seattle**

Developed and executed strategies to achieve the port's state legislative goals. Prepared legislative agenda and advised five elected commissioners and the CEO. Tracked legislation, conveyed port positions to lawmakers and key legislative staff, testified on bills of interest, wrote position papers, supervised contract lobbyists and built industry and public agency coalitions in support of port positions. Also worked with congressional delegation and staff on state-oriented issues. Frequently asked by legislators to address visiting groups and delegations about trade subjects or lobbying process. Experienced in managing relationships with public affairs firms.

Served on a number of transportation committees and staffed efforts such as the Governor's Competitiveness Council, Global Competitiveness Council and Washington Transportation Alliance. Serve on Puget Sound Industrial Excellence Center Board and as Legislative Committee Chair of Washington Air Managers Association. Helped to staff governor and lieutenant governor with written background papers and remarks/speeches on trade missions and port customer calls overseas.

### *December 1994 to December 1995*

#### **Manager, Local Government Relations; Port of Seattle**

Designed and executed strategies for advancing port goals in local and regional political arenas, particularly in the Puget Sound Regional Council. Coordinated lobbying and media activities leading to council approval of third runway at Sea-Tac Airport. Credited with developing stronger Regional Council support of airport expansion and mitigation programs. Also represented port to Seattle city government and King County executive and council branches.
