

Ref is the program manager for King County's Jobs Access Reverse Commute Program, and the County's Employer Transportation Program as well as part of the team working on the county's climate change efforts. Ref has also been a longtime board member of the Green Lake Community Council, the City Neighborhood Council and is one of the founding board members of Puget Sound Bike Share. He has served on more than one iteration of the Citizens Transportation Advisory Committee, including chairing the effort that led to the 2006 Bridging the Gap proposal.
