Protecting the Viaduct





Increasing Work Opportunities for Disadvantaged Businesses

WSDOT has signed a Conciliation Agreement with FHWA that:


- Contains steps that both agencies have agreed are necessary to improve oversight and enforcement of DBE requirements.
- Outlines additional resources that the agency and STP are dedicating to increase DBE participation.
- Includes reporting mechanisms that will remain in place through the life of the project.
- Sets the course for WSDOT's DBE efforts moving forward.

WSDOT and STP reached a separate agreement that:

- Requires STP to provide \$96 million in work on the tunnel project to certified DBE firms.
- Requires STP to hire a third-party independent program coordinator to review their DBE subcontracting activities and procedures and verify compliance.
- Withdraws WSDOT's earlier finding against STP for breach of contract.
- Enables WSDOT to either reinstate the finding or implement other appropriate contract actions should STP fail to comply with the terms or conditions of the agreement.




SR 99 Tunneling Machine's Current Location






Seal System Gaps on the Tunneling Machine






Building the Access Pit






Tunneling into the Access Pit






Repairing the Seal System
