COUNCIL BILL	

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Department of Finance and Administrative Services; increasing the business license fee, and amending Section 5.55.030 of the Seattle Municipal Code.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Effective for Seattle Business licensees to engage in business in 2015 and subsequent years, Section 5.55.030 of the Seattle Municipal Code, last amended by Ordinance 123361, is amended as follows:

5.55.030 License Requirements

A. No person, unless specifically exempted, shall engage in any business activity, profession, trade or occupation in the City without having first obtained and being the holder of a valid and subsisting license to do so, to be known as a "business license." The fee for the business license shall be ((\$90.00))\$110.00 for persons with worldwide gross income of the business and value of products of more than \$20,000 in the current calendar year that engage in any business activity, profession, trade or occupation in the City prior to July 1st and ((\$45.00))\$55.00 for persons beginning their activity on or after July 1st. The business license fee for persons with worldwide gross income of the business and value of products of \$20,000 or less in the current calendar year will be ((\$45.00))\$55.00 if prior to July 1st and ((\$22.50))\$27.50 for persons beginning their activity on or after July 1st. The fee shall accompany the application for the license.

The business license shall expire at the end of the calendar year for which it is issued. The business license shall be personal and nontransferable except as provided in subsection G, Tony Kilduff LEG Business License ORD October 27, 2014 Version #1

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below. Applications for the business license shall be made to the Director of Finance and Administrative Services on forms provided by the Director. Each business license shall be numbered, shall show the name, place and character of the business of the licensee, and such other information as the Director deems necessary, and shall at all times be conspicuously posted in the place of business for which it is issued.

If the licensee changes the place of business, the licensee shall return the business license to the Director and a new license shall be issued for the new place of business free of charge.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 30 days after its approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten days after presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Seattle Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.

Legislation Title:

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Department of Finance and Administrative Services; increasing the business license fee, and amending Section 5.55.030 of the Seattle Municipal Code.

Summary of the Legislation:

This legislation would increase the business license fee from \$45.00 to \$55.00 for businesses with annual revenues less than \$20,000 and from \$90.00 to \$110.00 for businesses with annual revenues greater than that starting in 2015.

Background:

The City charges a license fee for most businesses that operate in the City—there are certain exceptions. The fees have not been adjusted since 2005 when they were increased from \$75.00 to \$90.00. The proposed increase generally reflects inflation since 2005.
