

She is the development managing director providing oversight on over 2.7 million square feet for Amazon's corporate headquarters in South Lake Union, which include 17 buildings that opened starting in 2010.

Sharon also oversees the redevelopment of the research facility campus for the University of Washington, School of Medicine in South Lake Union. This project includes a redevelopment of an existing office building and new biomedical/office buildings for a total campus buildout of over 900,000 square feet.

Her expertise includes site evaluation and project feasibility as well as design and construction of commercial projects. Her background includes a focused expertise in adaptive reuse of historic landmark structures and transportation and sustainability initiatives.
