

Amendment #9 Limiting Replication

This amendment is intended to make it more difficult for TNCs licensed by the City to replicate their businesses under a different name, or for an entity to create a holding company to achieve the same end.

Accordingly, amend Section 9 as follows:

SMC 6.310.260 Transportation network company license eligibility and application

A. Any business or individual desiring to operate as a transportation network company within The City of Seattle shall file with the Director a signed and notarized transportation network company license application on forms provided by the Director.

1. To be eligible for a license, the transportation network company is limited to providing application dispatch services to transportation network company drivers meeting the requirements set forth in Section 6.310.452; further, no TNC licensed by the City of Seattle shall own or be owned, in whole or in part, by any other TNC licensed by the City of Seattle, or be owned in whole or in part by any party or entity owning, in whole or in part, another TNC licensed by the City of Seattle.
