Gentlemen:


I hereby disapprove Council Bill No. 42,787, and am returning it to you for your further consideration. I am disapproving it because I feel that it in reality will work a hardship on day labor instead of being a benefit thereto and will result in a lowering of the present wages in the large majority of cases.

After consultation with the members of the Board of Public Works I also find that it will render more difficult the carrying on of the work of some of the departments as regards emergency work of all kinds.

My veto will enable you gentlemen to go into the merits of the bill more fully and decide whether the objections raised both by men and department heads can be justified.

Budget season seems the reasonable time to consider such matters, when full consideration of the merits and demerits of such a policy could be given.
