

We are in receipt of your communication of recent date in reference to petition No. 114063, signed by certain property owners against the maintenance of a dairy barn at 2621-20th Avenue West, in the City of Seattle, owned by one, Louis Gaultieri.

This is to confirm conversation between Mr. Gaultieri, Dr. Smith and Mr. Frasch, on December 31st, Mr. Gaultieri agreeing to vacate and raze dairy barn by April 1, 1928, or dispose of the cattle and convert the stable into some other use, or raze it, which will eliminate all complaints against this particular dairy barn.
