P R O C L A M A T I O N

I, CHARLES L. SMITH, Mayor of The City of Seattle, do hereby
certify and declare that the proposed amendment of Article VII/by
adding a new section to be known as Section 1-A, to read as follows:

"Section 1-A. There shall be maintained adequate police protection in each district of the city and there shall be maintained at least one police sub-station in each of the following districts in the city: One in the University District, one in Ballard, one in West Seattle, one in Columbia and one in Georgetown; the personnel of the police department shall consist of not less than five hundred and seventy-one (571) persons.",

submitted to the qualified voters of the City of Seattle for their approval or rejection, at the general municipal election held in said City on Tuesday, March 10, 1936, pursuant to Ordinance No. 66022, received the approval of a majority of the qualified electors voting at said election on said proposed amendment; and I do hereby

PROCLAIM that said proposed amendment has by virtue of said approval by said electors become, and is, a part of the City Charter of The City of Seattle.
