WHEREAS: a committee will on this day, October 24, 1936, be present in Washington, D.C. to present demands to President Roosevelt for an increase in pay to all WPA workers, and for more adequate and proper relief for the unemployed and part-time workers, for union rates of pay on all WPA projects with the six-hour day and five-day week with no loss in pay for sickness or rain, or for any other cause beyond the control of the workers on WPA projects.

THEREFORE: Be it resolved that the City Council memorialize President Roosevelt that these demands of the workers be granted.
