Your License Committee which was directed to investigate the advisability of revoking the license of the Deutches Haus at 613 9th Avenue on account of alleged Nazi activities therein beg leave to report that your Committee has investigated this matter and has received from the officers of said organization a statement in writing to the effect that to their knowledge no such activities have been permitted in the hall of the organization and that no lease of said hall will be made to any group which has as one of its objects the promoting of Nazi principles.

Your Committee therefor recommends that no action be taken looking towards the revocation of such license

RE: Your Resolution to investigate an alleged pro-Nazi meeting held in the German House on November 9 - 32.

We, the officers of the German House, beg leave to submit to you the following statement:

The rental of our hall for the meeting was done in the due course of business without our knowledge of the purposes of the meeting. We did not attend that meeting and have no direct knowledge as to what transpired at same.

However, as loyal American citizens, we pledge ourselves not knowingly to rent our premises to any individual or organization for the purpose of anti-American propaganda be that Communist, Nazi or Fascist.
