Gentlemen:

On March 25, the Public Safety Committee of the City Council, in considering Council file No. 169237, regarding the shack elimination, appointed a committee of four, consisting of Commissioner of Health, Chief of Police, Superintendent of Buildings and Chief of the Fire Department, to consider the matter and proceed with the destruction of certain shacks.

On April 29, the Public Safety Committee, while again considering this subject deemed it adviseable to place a full time man on this work and at that time thought that possibly a man could be detailed from either the Police Department or the Fire Department.

We are now informed that no such man is available and request that we be allowed to appoint one additional sanitary inspector from the civil service eligible list, and that money be appropriated from the emergency fund to pay his salary.
