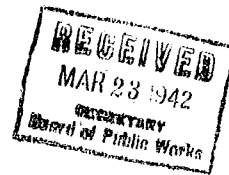

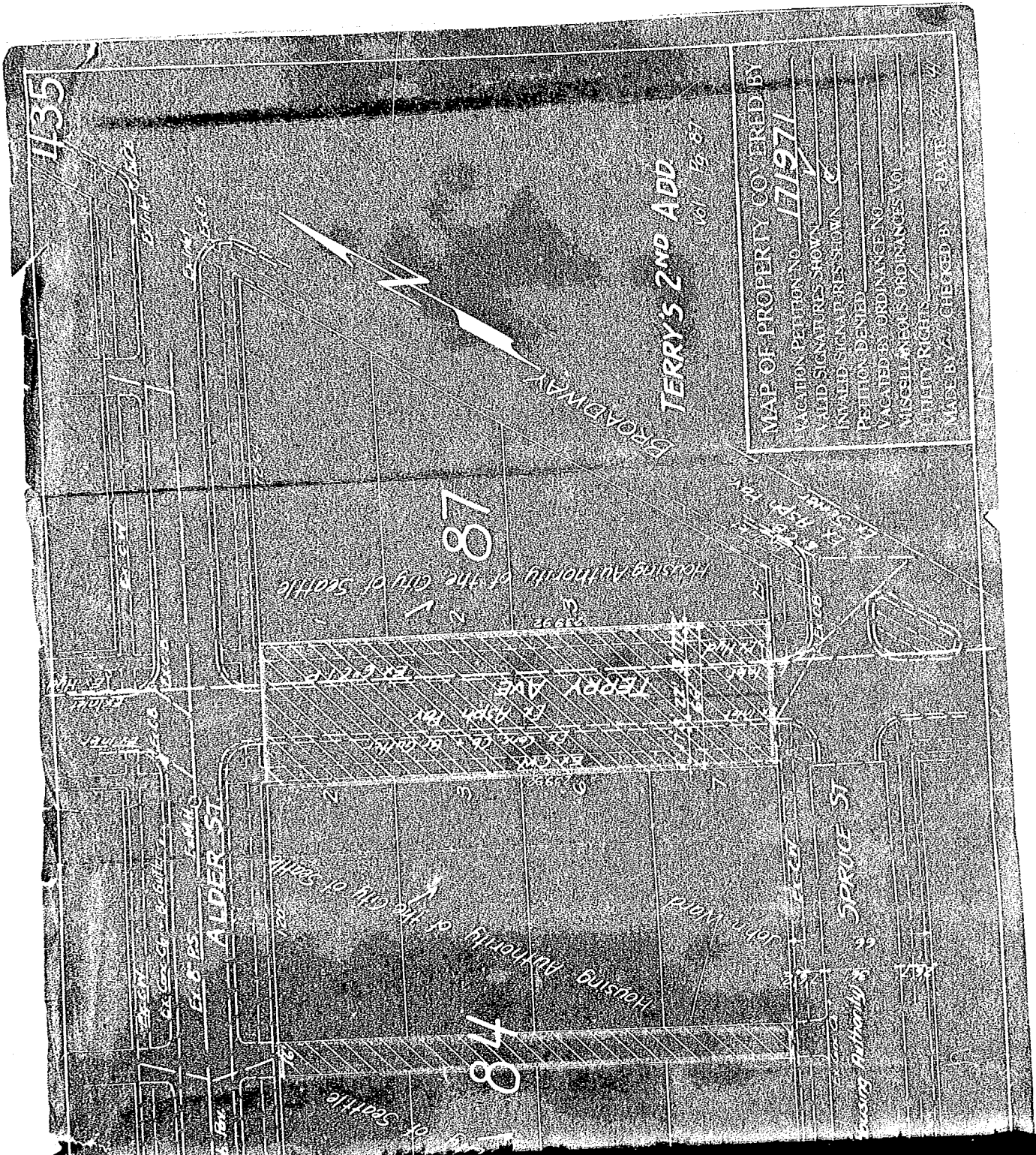

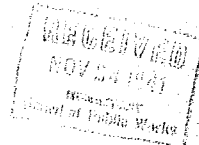

Gentlemen and Madam:

Pursuant to Paragraph 7 of the Cooperation Agreement between the City of Seattle and the Housing Authority of the City of Seattle dated November 6, 1939, we hereby respectfully petition your Honorable Body for the vacation of Terry Avenue and the alley situated in mid-block between said Terry Avenue on the east and Ninth Avenue on the west. The portion of said Terry Avenue and alley sought to be vacated is bounded on the north by Alder Street and on the south by Spruce Street.

The Housing Authority of the City of Seattle is the owner of at least two-thirds of all property fronting on both sides of those portions of said Terry Avenue and the alley, the vacation of which we are seeking.

For your information, this Authority is seeking the vacations herein petitioned for in connection with the development of the Yesler Terrace Addition, Project No. WASH-1-5, the location of which was filed with you by virtue of our letter dated December 2, 1940.
