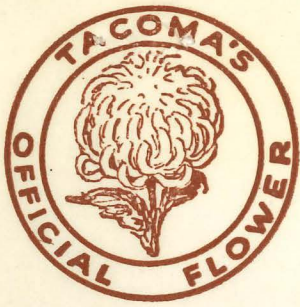

Dear Councilmen:

At a recent meeting of the Tacoma & District Chrysanthemum Society a lengthy discussion was held regarding the city of Seattle choosing the Chrysanthemum as their city flower. The general opinion of our members was that it did not seem practical that two neighboring cities should adopt the same flower and in so much as the City Council of Tacoma, under resolution No. 10413 dated November 7, 1934, adopted the Chrysanthemum as the official flower of our city.

We are of the opinion that a more friendly competition between the flower lovers of our two cities would be maintained if Seattle would forgo the adoption of the Chrysanthemum.

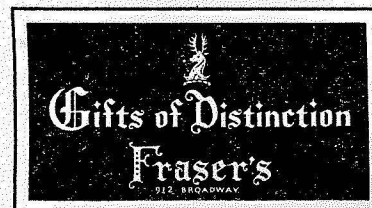
