WHEREAS, a petition was filed with the Board of County Commissioners for annexation of territory (Northeast area) hereinafter described to the City of Seattle, and

WHEREAS, a hearing on said petition was had before the County Commissioners on the 20th day of July, 1953, and

WHEREAS, on July 20, 1953, Resolution No. 14128 was passed by the Board of County Commissioners directing that an election be held in territory hereinafter described for presenting the proposition of annexation to the City of Seattle to residents within said area, and

WHEREAS, said election having been duly held on the 15th day of September, 1953, and the returns having been filed and canvassed by the Election Board of King County, Washington, with the following results:

For Annexation to the City of Seattle 1697

Against Annexation to the City of Seattle 384

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of King County, Washington, that said proposition carried, and that said area contains the following described territory, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the present city limits at the intersection of the center line of 1st Avenue Northeast with the center line of East 125th Street; thence North on said center line of 1st Avenue Northeast to the center line of East 145th Street; thence east on the center line of East 145th Street and the same produced to the middle of Lake Washington; thence southerly along the center line of Lake Washington to the present city limits at the intersection of said center line with the production east of the center line of East 125th Street on the south line of Section 22, Township 26 North, Range 4 East, W.M.; thence following present city limits west to 40th Avenue Northeast, south to East 120th Street, west to 15th Avenue Northeast, north to East 125th Street, and west to point of beginning at 1st Avenue Northeast.
