Dear Sirs and Madam:

The Federal Government has made available funds to the State of Washington which in turn are to be made available to Seattle and King County to conduct a Polio Immunization Program in Seattle and King County.

The Department has just been advised by the State Department of Health of the requirements set forth by the federally-approved State Plan.

It is necessary for this Department to encumber \$26,012.00 the amount of money allocated to Seattle and King County by February 15th to qualify under this plan. A certain amount of vaccine is now available and we are formulating an immunization program to make use of the present amount and other vaccine as is made available to Seattle and King County.

We would respectfully request that your Honorable Body make available by an emergency appropriation \$26,013.00 to be used in the Polio Immunization Program of which 28% will be chargeable to King County and 72% to the City of Seattle, all of which will be reimbursable to Seattle and King County by the State Department of Health.

Attached is a copy of budget compiled by this Department covering the program.

Your early action on this request will help greatly in getting the Program under way.
