
Dear Sirs and Madam:

The addition of poliomyelitic antigens to those formerly offered in the Well Child Clinics has stimulated a substantial increase in the number of children brought to these clinics for immunization. The increased demand for immunization for poliomyelitis, diphtheria-pertussis-tetanus and smallpox for preschool children is highly desirable from the standpoint of achieving adequate protection for this most highly susceptible portion of the population. However, it is now apparent that the money and vaccine remaining from the school immunization program is insufficient to supply these clinics for the balance of 1958. The available supply of polio vaccine will be exhausted about July 1, and at the current rate of use of about 2500 cc per month, 15,000 cc additional vaccine (\$7500.00) will be needed to meet the probably demand for immunization of preschool children during the last six months of 1958.

Sixty-seven percent (67%) of the requested \$7,500.00 to come from the City of Seattle amounts to \$5,025.00.

Thank you for your consideration of our combined (City and County) request for \$7,500.00 additional money for the 1958 polio immunization program.
