Gentlemen:

On January 19, 1959, you granted the vacation of the south 12 feet of East Valley Street between 34th Avenue North and 36th Avenue North, as requested by Property Owners in Comptroller's File No. 235471, subject, of course, to the usual conditions of appraisal.

We are now advised by Mr. Thomas H. Meadowcroft, one of the petitioners, that the other petitioner is unwilling to complete the vacation insofar as the portion of East Valley Street west of the alley between 34th Avenue North and 36th Avenue North is concerned.

Mr. Meadowcroft requests that the portion east of the alley, which abuts upon his property, be vacated.

The petition contains a clause which will permit the City Council to vacate a portion of, rather than all of, the proposed vacation, if it so desires.

We recommend that the City Council withdraw Comptroller's File No. 235471, re-refer it to the Board of Public Works for a report on the vacation of only the east one-half of the original petition, and then reconsider the revised petition in committee.

We enclose Mr. Meadowcroft's letter of March 16, 1959, with a further recommendation that it be attached to Comptroller's File No. 235471 to serve as an amended petition. We also enclose a sketch showing the new request.

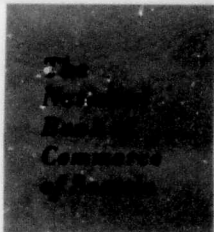


