

In line with our recent conversation, I represent a lady who teaches astrology. She and a number of other reputable astrologers in our city are quite disturbed about City Ordinance No. 12.11.240 which includes the casting of horoscopes in that section of the ordinance which makes it unlawful to engage in gambling, bunko or swindling games, or to engage in telling of fortunes or the reading of palms. It is the contention of astrologers that astrology is a science and is definitely not a bunko game and it should never have been included in the ordinance.

The fact that horoscopes are carried in our daily papers and that there are many books on astrology which are obtainable in the library and in book stores would be strong evidence of the fact that it is not a bunko game nor a fraud on the public. We may not agree with their theories but that is quite a different thing from being fraudulent.

I talked to Mr. Erlandson, the Controller, and he said they've had no problems at all with astrologers and I also talked to Chief Ramon of the police department and he said they've had no problem. He also said he had no objections to eliminating the words "or the casting of horoscopes" from the ordinance. He said that he did not know it was in there, he did not ask that it be put in there and did not know how it got there. He stated that he simply wanted the ordinance to conform with the state law which prohibits fortune telling, palmistry or clairvoyance but says nothing about horoscopes or astrology.

I do not know of anyone who would object to the action of the City Council in eliminating the reference to the casting of horoscopes from the ordinance. I believe it is only right
