

Subject: Recommended wording for street naming ordinance

There is a road in the University of Washington Arboretum at present unnamed which starts at Lake Washington Boulevard E. in the vicinity of E. McGraw Street, extending in a general easterly direction about 800 feet to an intersection with Arboretum Drive E., then continuing an additional 500 feet, more or less, in a northeasterly direction to a dead end.

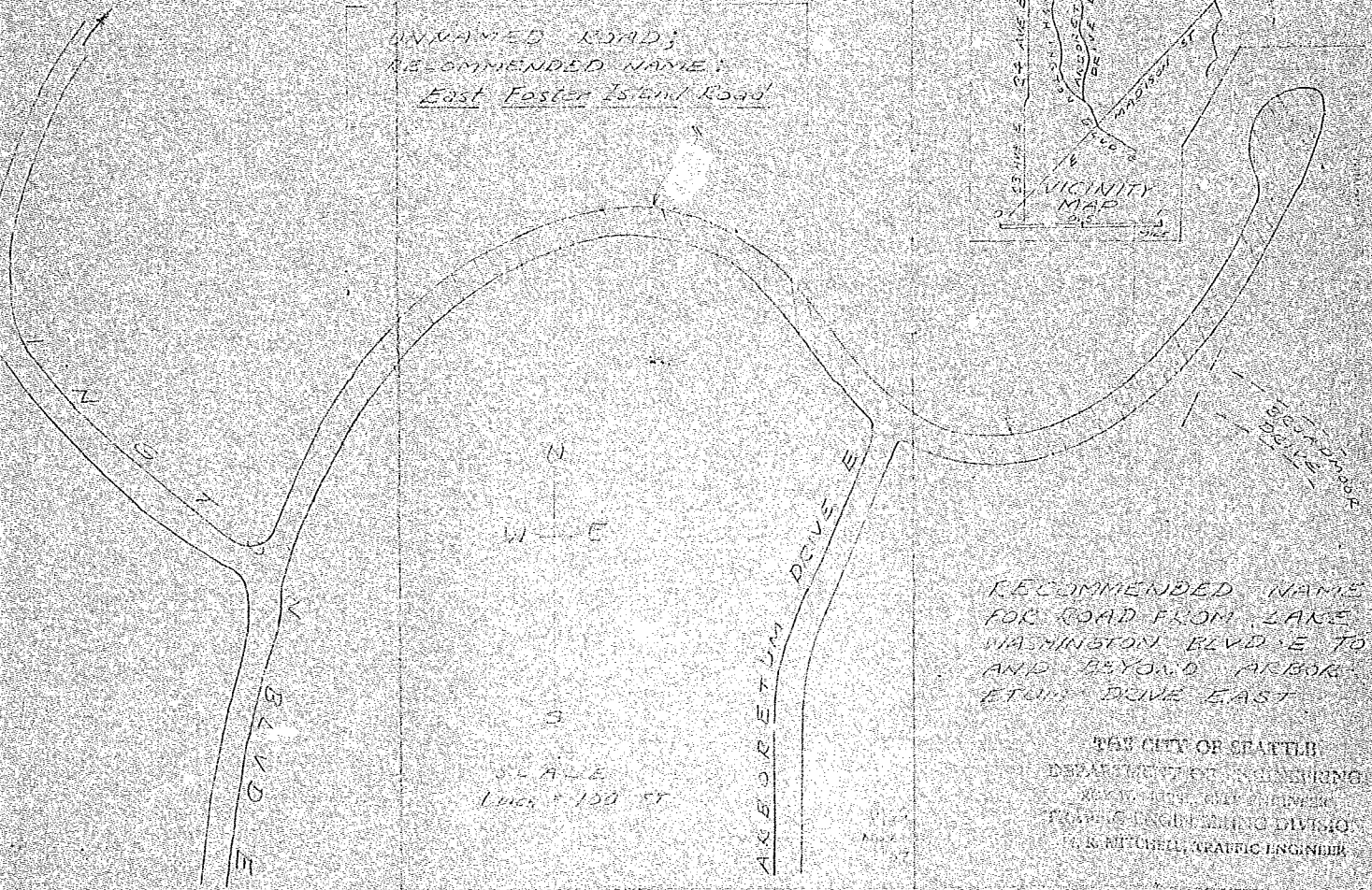
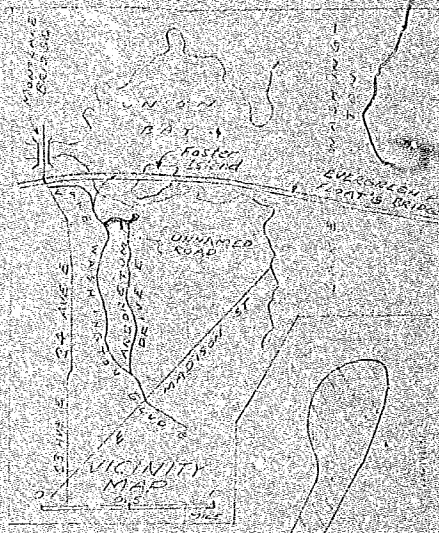
It is recommended that the above-described road be named "East Foster Island Road".

East Foster Island Road

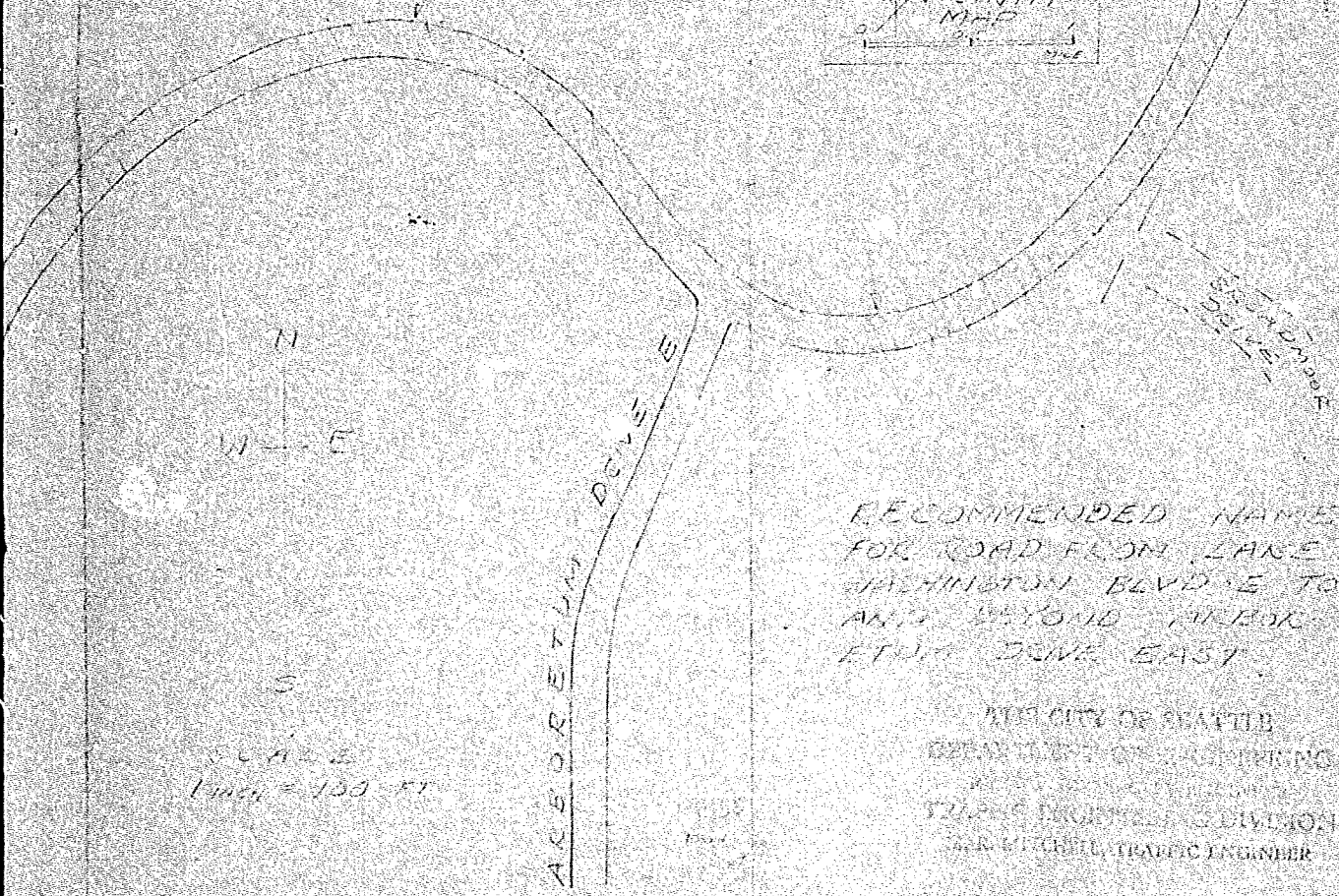
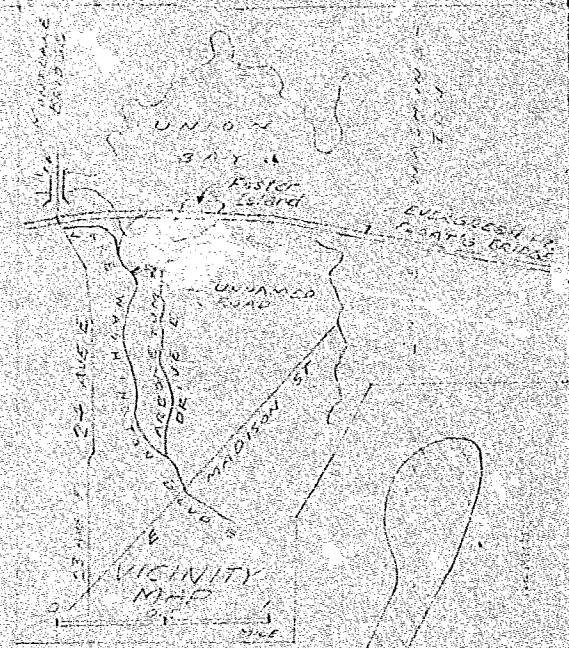
