I thought perhaps I would write you a short letter thanking you for your visit on Monday, and for the work that must have been done by you in securing the signatures on the petition which you left with me.

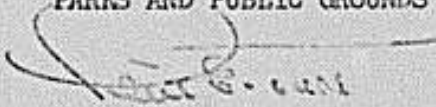
As I indicated during the course of our conversation, we on the Council are very concerned as to the desires of the Director of the Seattle Center, who is in charge of Sicks' Stadium, for presentation of rock concerts there. As I indicated, we have placed many restrictions on a possible rock concert to the point where I would seriously doubt if a promoter would desire to use the stadium unless he had a national rock group as a drawing card.

Please be assured that any rock concert will not last more than five hours, will be on a Saturday evening, and will be well policed. This is in addition to the fact that it would only be for a single performance, and another rock concert could not be had at the stadium for another two weeks. I believe that the Council has made every effort to insure that the concert would not be one which would create any problems of embarrassment, or disturb the peace and tranquility of our citizens.

If at any time I can supply you with any further information relative to rock concerts at Sicks' Stadium, please feel free to call me.

We are the owners of a four-plex at 3221 Pioneer Ave. So and as taxpayers wish to protect and express concern that even the idea of introducing Rock Festival to the area is abhorrent. It could only serve to degrade, down grade and smother the residents and businesses in proximity to it.

Having relatives and friends in the Duwamish area and hearing from them the conditions, sights, sounds, conduct and smells of participants of such festivals, even in rural settings - why would the Council even consider drawing such into the city. These people could and probably would over-flow and invade the rights of others and the immediate vicinity of the Stadium would not contain them. They attract many who flaunt their contempt of any restraint. Could you possibly police such an invasion. What about the drug problem and consequences.

We lived from 1952-1966 in the Lakewood area and, much as we enjoyed hydrating we did observe the terrible mess left behind by ordinary picnickers after a day of recess. No sure homeowners would not want such foul debris in their yards and streets as there would surely be if a Rock Festival at Slick's Stadium. The element that attend such things have little regard for the "establishment" as ordinary citizens are called.

Again - the noise of "Rock". Do you know the good people of Duwamish had no sleep that night - for a distance of about one mile. Walls won't keep it out. No sure our tenants will terminate occupancy if such is the case.

If Rock Festivals become "the thing" at Slick's Stadium, some of the "Rock" element might like to locate permanently in the area, and they haven't exactly the same manner of living to be compatible with

the best interest of any Community - no matter what their rights are, you know, we have our right too. - And what is more, we pay taxes for those rights - which is more than can be said of the many of the "hip" generation.

Please let us have as much peace and order as you can. This is a form of pollution you know - air waves. (Sound Pollution)

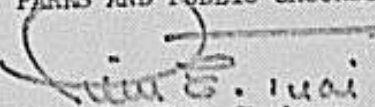
