The Public Safety Committee of the City Council, at its meeting on December 23, 1970, had before it File No. 268526, petition of Rainier-Seacon Junior Chamber of Commerce for amendment of the Teen Dance Ordinance to permit longer hours for such dances on New Year's Eve.

After considering the reports of George Tielsch, Chief of Police, and John Fearay, Director of the Seattle Center, the Committee recommended:

1. Your dance, scheduled to be held at the Seattle Arena, be allowed to continue until 1 a.m. However, it should be understood that the Arena is to be entirely cleared by the 1 a.m. deadline.

Returned herewith is the petition of Rainier-Beacon Junior Chamber of Commerce for amendment of the Teen Dance Ordinance to permit longer hours for such dances on New Year's Eve.

Amendment to the Teen Dance Ordinance, as requested, appears reasonable. Any problems created as a result of this amendment would most probably be minor in nature. Your attention is called to the fact that Section 7B-0 (e) describes two age groups, under fifteen and fifteen years and over. I believe the amendment should only apply to the latter group.

It is our belief that the present ordinance could be updated. The Mayor's Youth Division and the Juvenile Control Division of the Police Department hope to develop a proposed ordinance for your consideration in 1971.

This is in reply to C. F. #268526, re Teen-Age Dance Ordinance.

Seattle Center wholeheartedly agrees with the request of Mr. J. D. Vega Jr. in requesting the extension of teen-age dance hours on New Year's Eve past 12:00 Midnight to 12:30 A.M. Regardless of his feeling of discrimination in paragraph two because of a charge for room service, I feel the important item here is to not release a large number of teen-agers to the streets at five minutes to Midnight on New Year's Eve.

It is our recommendation that his request be granted provided sufficient security is maintained by his organization over the event.

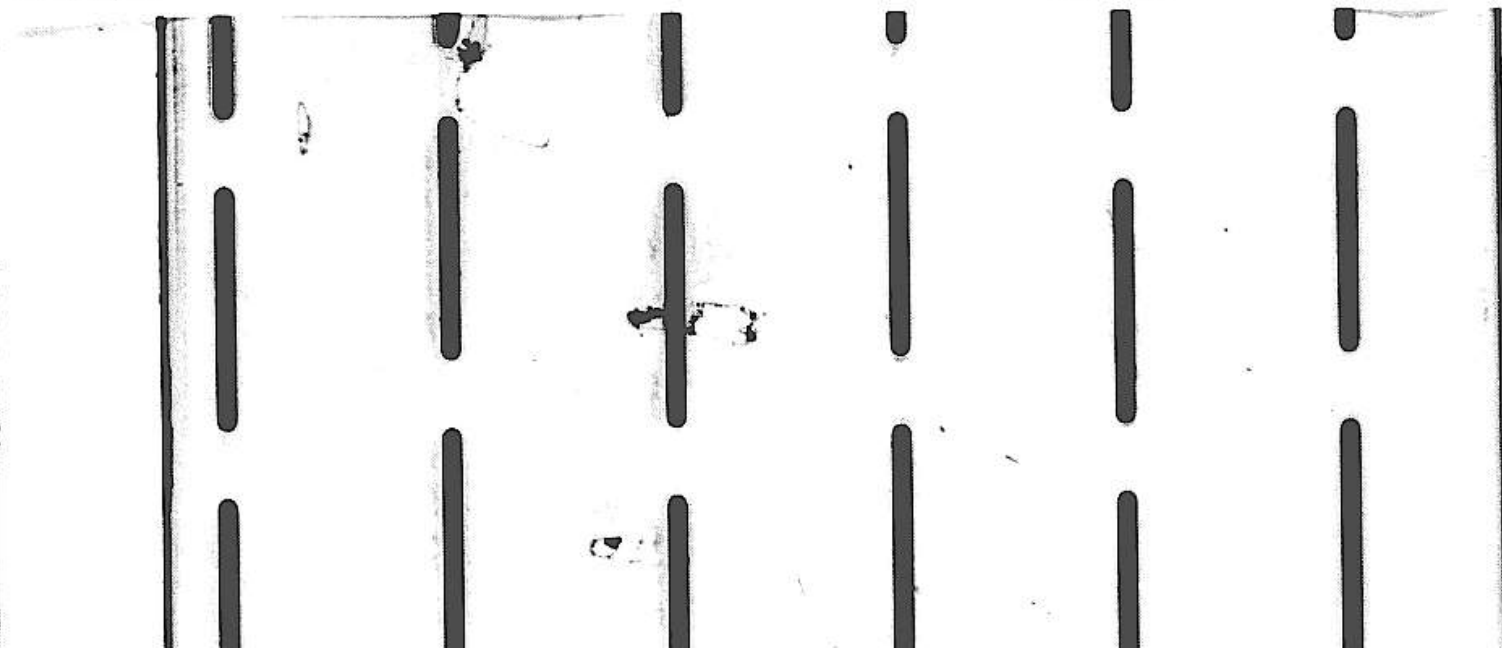

RE: The City of Seattle's Teen Dance Ordinance

Dear Sir:

We would like to submit a request that the present City of Seattle's Teen Dance Ordinance be extended: from 11:45 p.m. to 12:30 a.m. on New Year's Eve, and that the City Council amend the existing Ordinance to allow for exceptions on New Years eve now and hereafter. The reasons for our request being:

- (1) We feel that the Teenagers would like to celebrate the coming of the New Year while they are out. Extending the curfew would enable them to do so.
- (2) Our dance is scheduled to be held at the Seattle Arena. The charge for use of the room is \$450.00. If adults were using the same room, up until 1:00 a.m., the charge would still be \$450.00. In our eyes, this is discriminating against teenagers. The present Teen Dance Ordinance does not give us a fair chance to raise the money for the room or give the teenagers a considerable length of time to enjoy themselves.

In conclusion, we ask that our request be given some thought and consideration. Please let me hear from you as soon as possible.
