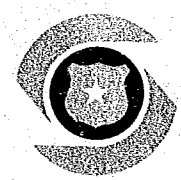

The Criminal Information Section provided security for three (3) dignitaries and visiting officials. The Special Patrol Unit supplied security on eight (8) occasions during 1986.


