AGREEMENT

SEOLA BEACH SEWER REHABILITATION PROJECT

COST SHARING

This Agreement is made and entered into this 28th day of Aug. 1992 by and between the City of Seattle's Engineering Department, a municipal corporation hereinafter referred to as SED, and the Southwest Suburban Sewer District, a municipal corporation hereinafter referred to as the District.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Seattle Engineering Department's Drainage and Wastewater Utility (hereinafter referred to as DWU) has identified an existing sewer pipe, owned by DWU, leading to the District's pump station in Seola Beach Drive Southwest as in need of maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the existing sewer pipes owned by DWU and the District leading into the pump station are inaccessible to maintenance equipment; and

WHEREAS, SED is planning a capital project to provide for installation of an access manhole; and

WHEREAS, the capital project will provide an access manhole that will allow maintenance of the existing sewer pipes which will benefit both the District and DWU;

NOW, THEREFORE, SED and the District agree as follows:

Section 1. SED shall undertake a capital project (hereinafter referred to as the Project) to provide for the installation of a new access manhole and replacement of existing sewer pipe which is owned by DWU and the District. The Project scope will include the replacement of a portion of the District's sewer facilities, as listed on Attachment A.

Section 2. The District will pay SED the actual cost of improvements to the District's facility. The District's share of the contract is detailed in attachment A and is estimated to be \$15,464. SED will transmit an invoice to the District documenting the actual payment to be made after construction is complete.

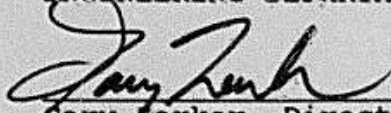
