To the Honorable, The City Council

of the City of Seattle:

Gentlemen:-- I return herewith Council Bill No. 321, entitled "An Ordinance authorizing and directing the Board of Public Works to grant a permit to Jos. Mayer & Bros. to erect an illuminated four dial E. Howard Street Clock in front of the entrance to the Colman Block," passed by your Honorable Body on May 21st, 1906, and presented to me on May 26th, 1906, without my approval, for the following reasons:--

1st. Since the passage of said bill, Jos. Mayer & Bros. have sold the clock and ornamental post therefor, and the same has been erected by Mr. Suter in front of his place of business in the Union Block, and Messrs. Mayer & Bros. have abandoned the idea of erecting and maintaining the clock in said bill provided for.

2nd. Section 96 of Ordinance No. 7040, entitled "An Ordinance regulating the construction, alteration, repair and removal of buildings within the corporate limits of the City of Seattle, and providing penalties for violation of the same" as amended by Ordinance No. 11706, approved November 30th, 1904, provides, among other things, that "Permanent posts on sidewalk or at curb will not be allowed under any circumstances in first building district, except ornamental iron posts for clocks or for illuminating purposes *****" and under said Ordinance No. 7040 and the Charter the Board of Public Works has power to grant permits for the erection of clocks, such as ~~that~~ provided for in Council Bill No. 321, without a special ordinance for that purpose.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Board of Public Works be and it is hereby authorized and directed to grant a permit to Jcs. Mayer & Bros. to erect and maintain an illuminated four dial E. Howard Street Clock in front of the Colman Building on First Avenue; said clock to be erected in a manner in every way satisfactory to the Board of Public Works and under its supervision.

Sec. 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the City Charter.
