Seattle, Wash. June 4th., 1906.

To the HONORABLE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEATTLE.

Gentlemen:-

I return herewith Council Bill Number 299, entitled:

An Ordinance providing for the improvement of Eastlake Avenue, from Denny Way to Roy Street, all in the City of Seattle, by paving the same with asphalt, laid upon proper concrete foundation, by constructing brick gutters, concrete curbs, with granite corners, together with all sewers and water mains, with appurtenances, necessary for the proper drainage, sewerage, water service and fire protection of said portion of said avenue, in accordance with Resolution Number 32 of the City Council of the City of Seattle,"

--passed by your Honorable Body on May 21st., 1906, and presented to me on May 26th., 1906, for the reason that Resolution Number 32, of your Honorable Body, declaring your intention to order the improvement of Eastlake Avenue, in the City of Seattle, from Denny Way to Roy Street, by paving the same with asphalt, laid upon proper concrete foundation, by constructing brick gutters, concrete curbs, with granite corners, together with all sewers and water mains, with appurtenances, necessary for the proper drainage, sewerage, water service and fire protection of said portion of said avenue, in accordance with plans to be prepared by the City Engineer, passed on the 21st. of April, 1906, was not published in the manner required by the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Seattle.
