David's experience includes residential, institutional, and mixed-use architecture at many scales, with a focus in urban design and in planning for the systems that enable resilient neighborhoods. At the block-, district-, and city-scale, his projects often include transit, public-private partnerships, form-based codes, blended funding sources, and significant public engagement. David spearheads GGLO's research into embodied carbon at the district scale and the firm's membership in the Seattle 2030 District.
