The Seattle Animal Shelter shall charge adoption fees based on the following chart:

	Dog	\$ 275	Age: over 6 months or under 11 years
	Puppy	\$ 375	Age: under 6 months old which is determined by the absence of adult canine teeth
	Special needs dog	\$ 100	Age: 11 years or older; or As designated by the Seattle Animal Shelter Director or their designee
	Rabbit	\$ 40
