To The Honorable City Counsel of the City of Seattle,
Washington:

GENTLEMEN:

We the undersigned residents of Queen Anne Hill, in Seattle, Washington, and living in the immediate vicinity of the following described lots to wit: Lots Eight (8), Nine (9), and Ten (10), in Block Thirty-seven (37), Bigelow's Addition to the City of Seattle, Washington, most earnestly object to and protest against the erection upon above described lots of the Children's Orthopedic Hospital now under contemplation of being constructed; for the reasons and upon the grounds that the said lots cover in all a space of but One hundred twenty feet by One hundred fifty feet in area, the same being entirely too small for the purposes intended; and for the further reason that the remainder of said block except Lot Six of same is improved by having built upon each lot a valuable residence and a family living in each of said residences; and for the further reason that said lots are in the heart of a choice residence part of the City and the property for many blocks from said lots, in case said hospital is built upon them will in consequence greatly depreciate in value; and for the further reason that said hospital is to be used for the treatment of deformed and crippled children and especially those who are deformed because of Tubercular troubles; and for the further reason that the sight of said crippled and deformed children being constantly before the residents in the vicinity of said hospital will be a constant source of annoyance and in fact may cause permanent injury to women under certain conditions of health and cause their children to be hideously deformed who are born under such conditions.

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We feel that the object for which said hospital is to be constructed is commendable but that under no circumstances should it be built in a choice residence portion of the City within the very door yards of the residents who have already spent many thousands of dollars in making permanent improvements on their property and we therefore beg of you that the permit to erect and conduct said hospital be by you denied.
