Gentlemen:-

At a meeting of the Board of Park Commissioners held this date, a committee from the Chamber of Commerce addressed the Board relative to the question of the city leasing the A. F. P. Exposition Grounds from the State, until May 1st, 1911 and maintaining the same as a public park.

In connection therewith, the following resolution was passed by the Park Board:-

"That provided the City Council shall see fit to negotiate the lease and make an appropriation of \$15,000. from the General Fund, that the Park Board will agree to maintain the grounds until May 1st, 1911."

Commissioners Cheasty, Schmitz and Ernst were appointed as a special committee to confer on the proposition.
