To the President and Members of the City Council, Seattle, Washington.

Gentlemen:

I am returning you herewith Council Bill No. 15101, being an Ordinance to prohibit smoking on or within the street cars while used for the carrying of passengers within the City of Seattle, except under certain conditions, and providing penalties for the violations of the provisions hereof which is disapproved.

The reasons for my disapproval are:

Because the ordinance, as drawn, could not be effectually enforced without placing policemen on practically every one of the cars; because the ordinance does not make the building of compartments for the use of smokers mandatory and throws all the burden of the penal clause upon the smoker and none upon the Company, and because the possible fine is, in my opinion twoo heavy considering the character of the offence.
