Referendum Petition Against Police Ordinance No. 30451

This to be returned on or before December 31, 1912, to 510 Leary Building.

To the City Comptroller, and to the Honorable City Council of the City of Seattle:

We, the undersigned, qualified voters of the City of Seattle, acting pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of Article IV of the City Charter, do by this petition invoke the reserved power of the simple referendum to be exercised and ordered as to that certain non-emergency Ordinance No. 30451 (commonly known as "Griffith's Police Ordinance"), and entitled "An Ordinance relating to the administration of penal justice in the City of Seattle and prescribing cases in which arrests may be made without warrants, and conforming the authority of the police of this city to the laws of the State of Washington, and providing penalties for the violation hereof," which said Ordinance was duly passed by the City Council on December 9, 1912, after reconsideration following disapproval and return by the Mayor with his objections thereto, and official publication thereof.

This ordinance prescribes the only cases in which a policeman may arrest without warrant and subjects any police officer who in the discharge of his duties makes any arrest without warrant in any case not prescribed to a fine of not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$100.00 or imprisonment not exceeding thirty days or to both, when convicted before any justice on complaint made by any person.

And your petitioners, respectfully ask that all necessary procedure set forth in and required by said Section 1 of Article IV of the City Charter for the exercise of said reserved power, be forthwith ordered and followed, and that the City Council provide for submitting the said Ordinance No. 30451 to the vote of the qualified electors of the City of Seattle for ratification or rejection at the next regular municipal election, to-wit, on Tuesday, March 4th, 1913.
