7. Introduction of bills by members and first reading.

8. Reports of standing committees, and second reading of bills.

9. Resolutions introduced and adopted.

10. Third reading of bills.

11. Unfinished business.

That Rule 41 read:

introduced by members

Bills ~~introduced by members~~ shall be referred to a committee, unless otherwise ordered. Bills introduced by committees shall lie on the table until the next meeting, unless otherwise ordered. A bill on first reading shall be read in full if demanded. The President may refer all bills, resolutions, petitions or other matters to a committee or committees without motion.

That Rule 42 read:

Every bill on second reading shall be read in full when demanded.

That Rule 58 read:

Smoking shall not be permitted within the council chamber during council sessions.

That Rule 63 read:

The Mayor, the President or the council, or any three councilmen, may call a special meeting of the council.
