BE IT REMEMBERED that the City Council met, as required by law, on Friday, the 7th day of March, 1919, at the hour of seven o'clock p. m., for the purpose of canvassing the returns of the general municipal election held in the City of Seattle on Tuesday, the 4th day of March, 1919, and on said canvass finds that the following named persons were elected at said election, to-wit:

For the office of Corporation Counsel, Walter F. Meier;

For the office of Councilman, C. B. Fitzgerald, Wm. Hickman Moore and Reginald H. Thomson.

That proposed amendment No. 1, amending subdivision "C" of Section 2 of Article IV of the city charter, relating to the salaries of councilmen, did not receive the necessary majority of the votes cast on said proposed amendment, and is declared NOT ADOPTED.

That proposed amendment No. 2, repealing Article XXV of the city charter, relating to the Municipal Plans Commission, did receive the necessary majority of the votes cast on said proposed amendment, and is declared ADOPTED.

That proposed amendment No. 3, repealing subdivision 32 of Section 18, Article IV of the city charter, relating to the liquor traffic, did receive the necessary majority of the votes cast on said proposed amendment and is declared ADOPTED.

That proposed amendment No. 4, repealing Section 17 of Article VIII of the city charter, relating to local improvements, did receive the necessary majority of the votes cast on said proposed amendment and is declared ADOPTED.

That proposed amendment No. 5, repealing Section 13 of Article VIII of the city charter, relating to local improvements, did receive the necessary majority of the votes cast on said proposed amendment and is declared ADOPTED.

That proposed amendment No. 6, amending Section 11 of Article VIII of the city charter, relating to local improvements, did receive the necessary majority of the votes cast on said proposed amendment and is declared ADOPTED.

That proposed amendment No. 8, amending Section 18 of Article IV of the city charter, by adding a new subdivision relating to civil service pensions, did not receive the necessary majority of the votes cast on said proposed amendment, and is declared NOT ADOPTED.

That proposed amendment No. 7, amending Section 12 of Article VIII of the city charter, relating to local improvements, did receive the necessary majority of the votes cast on said proposed amendment, and is declared ADOPTED.

That proposed amendment No. 9, amending Sections 1 and 20, Article X of the city charter, relating to the term and powers of the Commissioner of Health, did not receive the necessary majority of the votes cast on said proposed amendment, and is declared NOT ADOPTED.


That Proposition "A", relating to the franchise given the National District Telegraph Company by Ordinance No. 38,413 and submitted to the people by referendum, did not receive the necessary majority of the votes cast on said proposition, and is declared NOT RATIFIED.

That Proposition "B", creating an indebtedness for the purpose of constructing a bridge across the West Waterway at West Spokane Street, did not receive the necessary majority of the votes cast on said proposition, and is declared NOT CARRIED.

That Proposition "C", creating an indebtedness for the purpose of constructing a bridge across the Lake Washington Canal at Montlake Boulevard, did not receive the necessary majority of the votes cast on said proposition, and is declared NOT CARRIED.

That Proposition "D", creating an indebtedness for the purpose of constructing and equipping a general municipal hospital, did not receive the necessary majority of the votes cast on said proposition, and is declared NOT CARRIED.
