Whereas, the City of Seattle has heretofore been successful in resisting the claims of the North Bend Lumber Company, the Chicago, Milwaukee & St. Paul Railway Company, and other claimants for damages alleged to have been occasioned by the construction and maintenance by the City of Seattle of the so-called crib dam at Cedar Lake and the so-called masonry dam across Cedar River below Cedar Lake, and,

Whereas, Three trials based on said claims, have been had in the courts in which the juries have either un-animously or nearly unanimously refused to hold the City of Seattle in any way responsible for said alleged damages; and the appropriation of \$175,971.00 for the payment of said claims is unlawful and unwarranted and a waste of public funds.

NOW THEREFORE, believing that Ordinance No. 46,791 entitled:

“An ordinance relating to and providing for the compromise settlement and payment of the claims of the North Bend Lumber Company, a corporation, and other claimants against the City of Seattle for alleged damages to property and making an appropriation therefor,”

passed by your body on the 14th day of April, 1924, is unwise, unjust and invalid and unjustifiably adds to the burdens of the patrons of the City Light Plant,

We, the undersigned, qualified voters of the City of Seattle, do hereby petition your honorable body to submit said Ordinance to a referendum vote of the qualified electors of said city.
