Gentlemen:

Under Resolution No. 8059 of the City Council there was referred to the City Planning Commission, among other proposed improvements, that of the extension of Lakeside Avenue through Leschi Park. We respectfully submit the following recommendations:

It is apparent that an extension of Lakeside Avenue through Leschi Park will in the future be necessary. At present Lakeside Avenue is but forty feet wide from its junction with Blaine Boulevard to the northern line of Leschi Park. This portion of Lakeside Avenue should be widened to eighty feet, and its alignment should be projected on lines of permanent location with the best possible connection with that of Lakeside Avenue as it now exists at the southern line of Leschi Park, regardless of the location of existing buildings or improvements. Those buildings or improvements within the limits of Leschi Park need not be disturbed for the present as it is possible to temporarily locate and construct a roadway through the park without disturbing them.


Gentlemen:


Gentlemen:
