

Dear Councilman Carroll:

The Seattle Charter Review Committee herewith respectfully submits for City Council consideration its recommendation that there be submitted to the voters in November, 1961, an addition to the Seattle City Charter providing that there shall be a Charter Review Commission established by ordinance, with members appointed by the Mayor, subject to City Council confirmation. This recommendation passed by a vote of 22 in favor, 2 opposed, and 2 abstaining.

Based principally on its own recent experience, the Seattle Charter Review Committee has concluded that it would provide for more orderly and efficient review of the Charter to have a Charter Review Commission established as a continuing body and thereby avoid the time wasted in organizing and establishing a new committee from time to time.
