We have completed checking The City of Seattle Initiative No. 80 petition, which was forwarded to our office on November 7, 2002. As you know, we had to delay the checking of signatures on this petition until we had certified the General election and completed our statutory recounts for the 47th Legislative District.

We began checking this petition on December 4, 2002. We completed it on December 19, 2002.

The results of canvassing the signatures are as follows:

Total Signature Checked -	23,625
Total Amount Needed -	17,229
Total Signatures Valid -	16,080

We have found the Seattle Initiative I-80 to be insufficient. The petition required an additional 1,148 signatures to be valid.
