RE: Seattle Initiative No. 80 – Petition

Dear Mr. Kline:

We have completed checking Batch No. 4 of The City of Seattle Initiative No. 80 petition. We have checked a total of 2,892 petition pages including the 94 petition pages of Batch No. 4. The results of canvassing the signatures are as follows:

Total Valid Signatures Needed	17,229
Total Valid Signatures Found	17,025

We are re-canvassing approximately 2,700 signatures which have been previously rejected as “not registered”. We have completed our backlog of registration forms from voters who missed the cut off date for the General Election.

As of today, we have found the Seattle Initiative I-80 to be insufficient. The petition requires an additional 204 valid signatures to be sufficient.

We will give you an update on the re-canvassing as soon as we have results. If we can be of further service, please do not hesitate to contact our office.
