

The City of Seattle is the managing member of Seattle Investment Fund LLC ("LLC"), an entity that received an allocation of federal New Markets Tax Credits ("NMTCs") in 2009. Pursuant to Exhibit A of Council Bill 116843, City Council has authorized the formation of an Investment Committee to make investment decisions and take other certain actions on behalf of the LLC.

Exhibit A of Council Bill 116843 also authorizes the formation of an Advisory Board to provide input to the LLC and Investment Committee regarding the particular needs of Seattle's low-income communities, projects that have applied for funding from the NMTC program and other matters affecting the implementation of the NMTC program.

The Advisory Board shall have seven members, five of which must reside or work in NMTC eligible areas or otherwise represent low-income persons. As indicated in the table above, the membership term shall be for three years, except the initial term for three members shall be two years. All appointees shall be confirmed by City Council.
