# PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the city of Seattle serves as a hub for arts and cultural activities and a home for outstanding artists and organizations that enrich our quality of life through visual art; and

WHEREAS, Bumbershoot®: Seattle's Music & Arts Festival is the biggest, boldest celebration of arts, music and culture in North America and features a wealth of visual arts variety and delight at the Seattle Center; and

WHEREAS, the Bumbershoot festival celebrates its 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary in 2010 -- a testament to the festival's enduring strength and to Seattle's rich history of creating and supporting music, art, culture and community; and

WHEREAS, the Bumbershoot Visual Arts Exhibits include unique spectacles including a 30-year look at Seattle alternative cartoonists and comics and a large-scale sculptural installation created from wooden coffee stir sticks; and

WHEREAS, the exhibition at City Hall "Umbrella for the Arts: 40 Years of Bumbershoot Artworks" showcases 40 years of Bumbershoot posters and original artwork created by artists who defined Bumbershoot's look over the past four decades; and

WHEREAS, Bumbershoot is an urban arts celebration like no other – one that highlights the remarkable vitality and diversity of visual art in Seattle and beyond;


