
WHEREAS, over those years, 250 clean ups have been organized, making Southeast Seattle more beautiful, with more than 1,500 residents and friends participating; and

WHEREAS, for many Southeast Seattle residents and allies, Bridge 2 Beach Earth Day Clean Up serves as their traditional Earth Day activity; and


