Managing Surface Street and Neighborhood Impacts of the SR 99 Tunnel Project

Seattle City Council is hosting a brown bag discussion to better understand issues raised by the Supplemental Draft Environmental Impact Statement (SDEIS), including the traffic data presented in the SDEIS, the potential traffic impacts on downtown and surrounding neighborhoods, and how these impacts can be mitigated.
